## Teatime Topics

Holland's two cheeses have been shipped to many countries for 300 years. Both of them are semi-soft, mellow and have mild, nut-like flavors.

Edam was developed early in the 13th century by farmers in northern Holland. It is a mixture of skimmed milk and whole milk.

Gouda, also named for a town in Holland, is made with whole milk.

The Holland cheese consumer bureau suggests that you always serve their cheeses at room temperature to bring out their full flavor.

If you cook them, always use a low, gentle heat to avoid toughening, stringing and separation. When the cheese is melted it is cooked.

Store Holland cheeses in airtight plastic bags or aluminum foil in the refrigerator.

To use the cheese as a special party fare, you need 1 lb. 14 oz.) at room temperature, 1/3 cup chutney, 1/3 cup mayonnaise, 1/4 teaspoon cury powder.

Cut a two or three inch diameter slice from the top of the cheese ball. Do not remove the wax coating from the slice or the ball.

Scoop out the cheese leaving 1/4 inch all around to form the shell. Put the scooped out cheese through a food chopper using the fine blade, or shred it with a vegetable shredder.

Gradually blend cheese, mayonnaise, chutney and cury powder in a mixer at medium speed. Mixture should be smooth and spreadable.

Stuff the cheese shell with the mixture. You will have enough filling to fill the shell twice. Serve at room temperature with breads, crackers, radish roses, cauliflower flowerets, green pepper and carrot sticks, crisp celery or cucumber fingers. Makes 2 1/2 cups of spread.

Tile Drainage Act. This is the legislation that, when a municipal by-law and other procedures are completed, enables the borrowing of three-quarters of the cost of tile drainage at a four percent interest rate for a ten year period.

Harold Clapp, Live Stock Branch, Guelph, advises of several cases of high nitrates in silage that have already occurred this year. In unusual cases nitrate accumulates in the plant. When ensiled, the nitrogen oxide gases form and could seriously affect humans.

On Sept. 15 ownership of the Rural Youth and Agricultural Centre was transferred to the Township of North Cayuga. The Township intends to have the centre remain available for farm organization meetings as usual. In due course a management committee is to be named.

In the meantime, the township has asked that bookings be made at the county agricultural office.
