Polish Pork Chops

4 loin, rib, shoulder or butt pork chops, about 1 inch thick; salt and pepper; 1 small onion, chopped; 1 (7 1/2 - ounce) can tomato sauce; 1/4 cup sherry; 1/2 cup commercial sour cream; 1 small dill pickle, chopped.

Brown chops in a greased heavy skillet; drain off any excess fat. Season chops with salt and pepper. Add onion, tomato sauce and sherry to pan. Cover and simmer gently over low heat for 45 to 55 minutes or until chops are very tender.

Transfer chops to a heated platter. Stir sour cream into pan juices and heat but do not allow to boil. Pour sauce over chops and sprinkle with chopped dill.

Makes 4 servings.

FRENCH PORK CHOPS: 4 loin, rib, shoulder or butt pork chops, about 1 inch thick; 2 tablespoons butter or margarine; 1 onion, thinly sliced; 1 carrot, thinly sliced; salt, pepper, thyme; 1/2 cup sauterne wine; 1/2 cup chicken broth or water; 1 (4 1/2 ounce) can sliced mushrooms; 1 tablespoon flour.

Brown chops on both sides in a greased heavy skillet; remove from pan and drain off any fat. Melt butter or margarine in the skillet and add onion, carrot and celery; saute for 3 or 4 minutes, then spread evenly over bottom of pan. Place chops on top of the vegetables and season with salt, pepper and thyme. Add wine and broth or water; cover pan. Bring to a boil, then lower heat and simmer gently for 45 or 55 minutes or until chops are very tender. Add mushrooms and their liquid to pan about 15 minutes before end of cooking time.

When done, remove chops to heated platter and keep hot. Blend flour to a thin paste with a little cold water and add to pan. Cook and stir until mixture boils and is thickened. Pour over chops.

Makes 4 servings.

VENETIAN PORK CHOPS: 4 or 5 loin, rib, shoulder or butt pork chops, about 1 inch thick; flour; 1 egg; 1/2 cup fine dry bread crumbs; 1 teaspoon salt; 1/8 teaspoon pepper; 1 large onion, cut into rings; 1 green pepper, cut into rings; 1 (19 - ounce) can stewed tomatoes; Oregano.

Preheat oven to 450 degrees.

Dredge chops with flour and dip in egg which has been beaten with a little water, then roll in seasoned crumbs to coat. Place in a single layer in a greased baking pan, preferably one which can be taken to the table because the chops look most attractive as they come from the oven.

Bake, uncovered, in preheated 450 degree oven for 30 minutes or until nicely browned. Remove from oven and lower temperature to 350 degrees. Arrange onion and green pepper rings on top of chops; pour on the tomatoes; sprinkle with oregano. Cover pan with foil. Return to 350 degree oven and bake for 1 hour or until chops are tender and well done. Uncover pan for last few minutes of baking time. Makes 4 or 5 servings.

Name For An Era

Periods of time acquire names. The "Gay Nineties" ended the nineteenth century, though one wonders if gaiety really was the chief characteristic of those who lived through that decade.

An earlier period has been tabbed "Mid-Victorian," a tribute Queen Victoria might not have appreciated if aware of all its implications.

This kaleidoscopic 20th century has seen the First World War, the Great Depression, the Second World War and the Cold War pass into history.

What name will finally attach to the present period, which, beginning in the 60s, has seen the coming of space travel, the contraceptive pill, the drug craze, long hair and beards, talk of a generation gap, awareness of environmental pollution, political assassinations and the questioning of every once-accepted system or tenet of religion, philosophy or morals?

"Space Age" and "Age of Aquarius" seem so far the leading candidates in the field, the latter disconcertingly indicative of the revival of astrology, a superstition the human race thought it had abandoned a century or more ago.

"Space Age" is the optimist's title. Pessimists counter that historians will dub it the "Age of Madness," the "Era of Insanity" or something equally unflattering, or even speculate that at its end no historian will be left alive to name it anything.

A compromise choice could be "Age of Communication," a neutral title not in itself indicating whether world wide dissemination of news and ideas at the speed of light helps solve or helps create the multiple problems of the day.
