

Hydro, Department of Lands and Forests, (both Fish and Wildlife and Research branches), and the Ontario Water Resources Commission had already begun the initial investigations to determine current patterns, water temperatures, water quality, zooplankton density and preliminary fish population indices in Lake Erie.

Lake Erie has a reputation which wanders from the "dying wasteland" description of some tourists operators. In fact, Lake Erie has three main basins which vary in their capacity to support fish and plant life.

Lake Erie is divided into three basins - Western, Central and Eastern. The Western basin, the shallowest, receives industrial and residential waste disposal from heavily populated - industrialized areas. The middle basin is less "polluted", the easter basin, where Nanticoke shares the shoreline, is the deepest area, and has lower levels of contamination than the central basin.


