Luther Marsh is located partly in West Luther township of Wellington county and partly in East Luther township of miles to the northwest of the Village of Grand Valley and Highway 9. The management area includes about 12,500 acres of water (Lake Luther) and surrounding land.

Management of the marsh by the authority and the department has been in effect for the last year and considerable improvements have already been made such as boat launching ramps and observation towers. Extensive crop management on lands within the area provides migrating waterfowl with food and refuge. Further developments, designed to assist the amateur recreationalist and ornithologist, will be made by placing more observation platforms and viewing
