

### Man Killed In Fire

Williams, 37, of Van Horne Ave., Willowdale, was killed in a flash fire in an electrical equipment room in the number one power house here Thursday.

Co-worker, Walter Urbanowicz was injured. He was treated for burns to his

Officials said the fire was apparently caused by a 600 volt cable on a scaffold but this is being investigated by Cayuga OPP. Investigating the matter are Consts. Walter Eaves and P. J. Helferty.

The accident was reported at 9 p.m. Dr. W. C. Mills of Dunnville was the coroner. The fatality was the first in nearly three years of construction at the Nanticoke Hydro site.
