He said the township has

the well-being of the

cottagers as well as all property

owners at heart.

"We don't intend to fight

with you people and if it's

necessary to amend our by-

laws we will amend them.

He said the amendments

for the by-law wouldn't be

easy because they had been

improved by the Ontario

Municipal Board after public

hearings.

One of the cottagers,

Raymond Fleet, of Peacock

Point, was charged by the

township of using a cottage

for a year-round residence

but he was acquitted at

Cayuga.

He said council had

prepared the by-laws with

the population as a whole in

mind and not to discriminate

against anybody.

"However, until these by-

laws have been amended we

will work according to the

book," he said.

He told the meeting that

here is a total of 931 cottages

along the lake front with an

average assessment of \$1,089

because they are zoned as

summer residential - less

than half the regular

assessment.

"This means they are

paying about \$100 each year

of which they receive a

government rebate of \$45,

leaving about \$55, they ac-

tually pay each year in

taxes," he said.

Mr. Miller contended that

many of the cottage lots

were not large enough to

comply with the by-law

regulation and won't have

sufficient land for expansion

of tile beds.

at the time the by-laws

were passed in 1968 were

classified as per-

manent homes.
