It is the first main transformer for Nanticoke.

The unique part of the moving job was the reason the barge had to be brought into Port Dover for unloading instead of Nanticoke.

Many people had asked why it wasn't unloaded at Nanticoke, which has a deep harbour. That was exactly the problem.

An engineer on the unloading crew told The Record that an exact depth of 10 feet of water was needed because it was necessary to sink the barge for the unloading.

Divers were used to clear the harbour basin of all debris before the delicate operation began.

The engineer said that even a pebble remaining on the bottom could possibly put a hole in the barge after it was sunk because of the great weight involved.

Calculations were made so the float carrying the transformer could be exactly even with the dock when the barge was filled with water. As soon as the float was unloaded the water in the barge was pumped out and it was on its way back to Hamilton, pulled by the tug Manitoba Lac.

The 215 ton transformer, the first of a \$1.8 million set of four units to be built at the Parsons-peoples plant at Edinborough, Scotland, was shipped from Edinborough on the "Kriwan" bound for Toronto, June 4. In Toronto it was lifted from the Kriwan to a truck float on the 50-foot wide barge - Cargo Master - for the trip through the Welland Canal to Port Dover.

The transformer (27 feet long x 13 feet wide x 17 feet high) will step-up the project's first generator output of 22,000 volts to 230,000 volts. Nanticoke Generating Station, the 77th generating station in Ontario, will require eight transformers to distribute its 4,000,000 kilowatts of electricity into the provincial transmission system. The first generating system at Nanticoke is expected to produce electricity before the end of 1971; consecutive units will be added annually until 1978.
