Spring Fire Danger Forecast - 1971

At the end of the 1970 fire season, water tables and levels were above normal in Northwestern Ontario, below normal in the northeast, and normal in Southern Ontario.

Low water levels and tables in Northeastern Ontario last fall contributed to below normal inflow measurements at a number of hydro reservoirs from November through to, and including, February. Inflow into the following lakes ranged from 30 to 70 percent of normal: Abitibi, Frederickhouse, Lady Evelyn, Rabbit, and Wanapitei.

Precipitation from November to the end of February was normal to near normal in all but the southern region where record high precipitation

amounts were established at some locations. Snow levels at mid-March varied from 24 to 30 inches across most of the northwestern and northeastern portions of the province. Approximately 36 inches of snow were reported at this time in the Sudbury-North Bay Area, and up to 42 inches in Parry

Sound and Pembroke Districts. Frost depths are considerably shallower than normal throughout the province. Normal spring rains and snow melt should result in a normal to slightly below normal spring fire danger period throughout Ontario.
