Changing Attitude

A person who was a nuisance to you, you sent him to a mental institution.

"In the last four or five years, the average length of stay in a mental institution has been reduced to months or even weeks."

The Saskatchewan hospital in North Battleford is an excellent example of this, says Mr. Benning. In 1967 the hospital has 1,250 patients and today has 554. Re-admission rates have dropped drastically as well.

A major part of Saskatchewan's community care program is the landlady project. Carefully selected landladies offer their home and a healthy family atmosphere to mental patients on the road to recovery.

Mr. Benning says the project, started several years ago, now has 121 former psychiatric patients living in 47 approved homes. Most are from the North Battleford hospital but an increasing number are coming from local areas.

The landladies are women with nursing training of housewives interested in helping people. They range in age from 21 to 68.

Mr. Benning says the women are selected on the basis of competence in meeting the physical and emotional requirements of their guests. Payments vary and are based on what type of care must be provided.

"We don't expect strict institutional standards. What we must basically have is a good head and a good heart."

"We try to make the needs of our client with the resources of the landlady. We want him to feel comfortable in his new surroundings and we try to make sure his environment is as close as possible to the one he left before being hospitalized."
