The federal food and drug directorate recently asked the drug industry to use safety packaging as a means of reducing the estimated 50,000 poison cases involving children last

year in Canada. Last year the greater one large Winnipeg hospital Winnipeg centre handled 1,574 cases that started out as emergency telephone inquiries. The total number of poison cases treated in direct by police officers was 1,016, including 571 processed by the poison control centre: Last year there were no deaths, but the average is up to three a

resemble candy. About one-fifth of the patients using the centre, involve an overdose, either because children got into containers A panel of local area or because parents didn't consult a doctor and gave too many pills to their children.

The poison control centre in the last 10 years has had four deaths involving headache tablets. Three of those have been due to parents giving children doses that were too great for the child's size and weight.

Second most common origin of child poisoning used to be sleeping pills, but now it is tranquillizers, says Dr. Gellman. The doctor says small children should
