The Ontario government should encourage establishment of an Indian-run community college on the Six Nations Reserve near Hagersville, Ontario Liberal Leader Robert Nixon said recently. These buildings previously housed the federally run Mohawk Institute, a former residential school for Indian children. The college could become a North American centre of Indian studies, he suggested.
