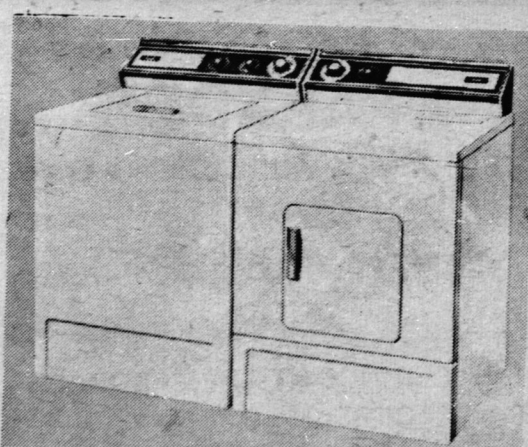

The Haldimand Adult Opportunity Centre will be holding its annual Open House on Nov. 8-12 at the Adult Training Centre on Highway 56, from 10 a.m. until 3 p.m. each day. On Wednesday and Friday, the Centre will be open until 9 p.m. to enable all to have an opportunity of attending sometime during the week.

The supervisor, Mrs. Ross Deagle and her assistant, William Brooks, will be present to explain the work being done by the trainees, most of it being done under contracts.

The workshop is designed to give employment training and assessment to mentally retarded adults from age 18

to 65. The trainees taught punctuality, procedures, work habits and a variety of independent.
