Continued From Page 1 there is hydrogen sulphide in the water. Sometime the smell (from the tank in town) is so strong it can wake you up out of a dead

Mr. Hopkins said it would be a matter of measuring the amount of hydrogen sulphide in the water and then designing the necessary aeration works.

He said it wasn't a matter of himself or the OWRC putting pressure on any one municipality (such as Brantford) to have a pipeline built, but it's a matter of "politicians pressuring politicians to get

it done." Reeve Kincaid said "its getting past the funny stage. Something has got to be done. We are not alone in this and we'll get the

support of the county." Mr. Hopkins told council to "get in touch with Kerr. Make a resolution or letter to him. This will bring it to his mind."
