REVEE JOHN KINCAID said that "over the years council has taken steps to make the plant better, yet we still as it should be. We spent \$35,000 two years ago and it never worked to my way of thinking. We still have to draw away the sludge."

It was explained that a sewage treatment plant is designed to take organic material from the water. The more efficient it is, the more organic material is removed. "A digester just makes solids less objectionable," he said.

Mr. Hopkins explained that just because the OWRC might take over the operations of the plant it does not mean there will be an automatic enlargement of it. "From our point of view we would like to see an efficient operation. There are limitations to the plant size in Hagersville and because of the limitations, it would be impossible to expand the present plant beyond its present size."
