but cannot cure those who do not come for help in time. Thousands of people feel there is no cure and so do nothing until too late, he said.

The new program, using news media, radio, television and volunteer workers is a "person to person" campaign. Mr. Rowland stressed the importance of service to patients, stating that in Ontario every device used anywhere in the world in the treatment of cancer is available. There is no need to go abroad for treatment, he said. A new machine may be moved on a loan basis, for one week, to outlying districts. He stressed the valuable therapy of the visiting service to patients.

Mr. Rowlands was presented with a bushel of Norfolk apples following his speech.

The treasurer's report indicates the total receipts for 1971 in the Norfolk Division were \$28,618. The objective last year was \$24,950. The Ontario Division raised a total of \$610,000 last year.

Reeve William Austin welcomed the group to Jarvis. Rev. Canon E. A. Brooks asked the blessing and W. Jackson gave the remarks of appreciation.
