For many visiting the show, nothing will be more thrilling than the pony pulls on Saturday and the horse pulls on Monday.

The Essex County Pulling Club of Harrow, Ont. will be organizing the pony pulls. Both attractions will be under the direction of Eddie Thompson, past-president of the society.

Each year the society is honored with the presence of the Miss Dairy Queen of Ontario, this year being Nancy Brown of Grand Valley, as well as Ontario's Queen of the Furrow, a Haldimand girl, Janice Fox. Both Queens will assist in the official opening of the show and all the grandstand parades on the weekend.

The show would not be complete without the annual interdenominational worship service held Sunday evening by the grandstand. For the 'casuals', bales of hay will be substituted for church pews.
