CAYUGA - All local farmers are advised to read Herb Norry's article on farm valuation that appeared in the Aug. 15 issue of Farm and Country. It is expected that programs will be held to explain farm valuation and Valuation Day values that would meet future requirements.

Valorie Bradford, Haldimand's Dairy Princess, participates in the Ontario Dairy Princess Competition at the C.N.E. on Thursday, Aug. 24. Her sponsors, the Haldimand Milk Committee, join the many others who wish her well in the Competition.

The Ontario Milk Marketing Board has announced that Market Sharing Quotas held by Ontario milk producers will be increased by five percent on Sept. 1. The O.M.M.B. will have additional M.S.Q. available for allotment to producers who apply for it.

Direct seeding of alfalfa was tried on several Haldimand farms this year with good results. Seeding in spite of conditions this spring was early enough that a first cutting will be possible before the end of August. This will allow for the alfalfa to add to root nutrient storage during the three weeks before and after Sept. 25 as is advised for this area.

The customary rule is no cutting or grazing of alfalfa from about Sept. 4 to Oct. 16. Cutting alfalfa before bud or early bloom can also be done because it tends to weaken the root system. Winterkill of alfalfa can be reduced by cutting alfalfa only after the bud or

early bloom stage and by resting the alfalfa field for three weeks before and after Sept. 25.
