of TB patients. By 1920, health departments in most parts of Canada were co-operating with TB associations in establishing TB programs, with Christmas Seal Funds employed to expand that partnership and spearhead new programs in diagnosis, treatment and prevention of tuberculosis,

and research. Christmas Seal Associations a c r o s s Canada pioneered mass x-ray surveys and have run these for nearly 30 years. While mass surveys are still being used in most provinces, they are primarily concerned with more remote areas, and particular groups.
