system of avoiding the problems of Niagara, which he said, are in many instances exaggerated.

Mr. Richardson said Niagara Region is a totally different type of area from Haldimand-Norfolk, with some good sized cities and towns with sizeable rural areas between. "This doesn't apply here. There are no large cities. I can see no reason why this area would have some of the experiences of Niagara, and we can learn from their experiences."

Bruce Meehan, deputy reeve of Walpole Township, asked who would take over the policing of the region. Mr. Richardson said it would depend on the system adopted. Policing could be retained as it is now, it could be done by a regional police force or each municipality could do its own.

Mr. Meehan said taxes increased 24 per cent in the first year of operation and are expected to increase 35 per cent this year.

Mr. Richardson replied that one could not overlook what those

costs are paying for. As an example, the cost of policing in Haldimand for the most part is done by the OPP and is not a direct municipal cost. It doesn't show up on the municipal budget. But it is still coming out of the taxpayers pockets.

Mr. Richardson was also questioned on the impact of a satellite city in the area. He said there has been no decision yet on the new city and the recommendations are still before the Ontario cabinet.

He said there would not likely be any development of a new town or city until later in the 1980s, but that the decision of what system of municipal government there would be for the area, would take a new town into consideration.

"We will have plenty of time to prepare for a new town," he said. "It is not likely that we will arrive at any substantial size of a new town until well into the late 1980s or early 1990s."

Reeve Clayton Smith, of Seneca Township, last year's warden of Haldimand, questioned whether there was enough time for councils to meet and prepare submissions for Mr. Richardson on his proposals. Mr. Richardson has asked that all submissions on his proposals be in to him by April 14.

Mr. Richardson said there were six weeks in which to discuss his suggestions, but "if some can't make it by that date, I would be willing to discuss an extension."

"However, the sooner we can get your opinions in, the sooner I can get down to work and complete my report."

David Wilson Sr., suggested to Mr. Richardson that "it doesn't make much difference what our feelings or thoughts on the matter are, you are going ahead with your report. You are only concerned with your report and the final result will be that we have no say in regional government."

Mr. Richardson said the only thing you won't have a say about is whether the present municipal system is changed. It is the expressed policy of the provincial government that municipal systems are to change and the provincial government was returned to office at the last election.

"However, it is not true that your voice won't be heard. I wouldn't be here tonight if this were true."

Mr. Richardson was asked what would happen if the development of a steel plant by the Steel Company of Canada does not take place by 1975.

He said he was not certain of the dates for the development of the Stelco development. But he was basing much of this on Stelco because of the enormous permanent work force it will bring. Texaco and Hydro are 'peanuts' in comparison to their
