why a change in govern-  
ment structure in itself  
should raise taxes.

There would be heavy  
initial capital costs  
attendant on the Nan-  
ticoke development and  
its effects, Mr.  
Richardson said.  
He said he would  
mistrust figures based

on the experience of  
other regions, even if  
available, because sit-  
uations differed and  
there is no way of  
differentiating between  
costs directly attribut-  
able to the type of  
government structure  
and those caused by  
other factors.

There is also the ques-  
tion of whether Cal-  
edonia should go with  
the Haldimand-Norfolk  
region or with a  
Hamilton - Wentworth  
region.

Mr. Richardson said  
he could see no great  
argument favoring why  
the town should go one  
way or the other.

He said the influence  
on the town from the  
industrial Nanticoke  
area will increase, but  
may never equal the in-  
fluence from the Ha-  
milton area.

The opinion of the  
town's residents could  
well be a deciding  
factor, he said.

Mr. Richardson was  
questioned for about two  
hours on his report by  
about 70 who attended  
the meeting.

His report, a series  
of suggestions on the  
restructuring of mun-  
icipal governments, was  
released two weeks ago.  
Meetings have been held  
throughout the two  
county area explaining  
the report. The report  
rejects the present sys-  
tem of local government  
and argues in favor of  
three other suggestions,  
a single-tier regional  
government, a two-tier  
regional government or  
a unitary system of re-  
gional government,  
which would establish  
three or four auton-  
omous municipalities.
