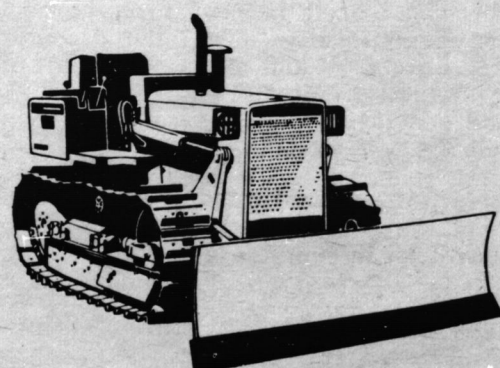

ROP-DHIAid Farmers

If you are a dairy farmer and you are not on R.O.P. (Record of Performance) or D.H.I. (Dairy Herd Improvement), this article could help you obtain greater returns from your dairy cows.

Many dairymen who are not on R.O.P. or D.H.I. often say - "I know what my cows are doing - I know how much they produce." If this is true, I can't help but wonder why our most successful dairymen are enrolled on R.O.P. or D.H.I.

The fact is, when most people enroll on R.O.P. or D.H.I., they often remark, why I thought Bessie was my best cow. These records show that most of the herd is better than she is.

Actually, determining the milk and butterfat production of each cow is only one piece of information that the D.H.I. program can provide.

For example, based on the production of each cow in the herd, D.H.I. reports indicate which cows in the herd should be culled.

The amount of grain that a cow receives is the most important factor determining the profitability of a cow. Based on the size, age, stage of pregnancy, and the production of a cow, the computer can determine the energy requirements of a cow and therefore the D.H.I. computer reports the amount of grain each cow can receive.

Reminders are given to the dairymen as to when certain cows are to be bred, when certain cows are to be pregnancy checked, when certain cows should be dried off, and when certain cows are due to freshen.

All of these factors can help you to increase the level of production in your herd, however, much is up to the dairymen to follow the recommendations provided to him in order to realize the potential increase in returns.
