CAYUGA - NIP is here. The National Identification Program for grade dairy cattle is available to dairy-men enrolled in D.H.I.A. and R.O.P. Grade animals may be identified in the NIP program in a process similar to registration of purebreds. Because the forms are handled through the D.H.I. supervisors or the R.O.P. inspectors, the cost is only 50 cents for each identification. Dairy-men on either of the test programs can enquire at the time of their next test for the necessary forms. To date some 11,000 identifications have been processed through D.H.I.A. ***

Co-operators on Can-farm with records up-to-date are presently studying the preliminary tax management report that this computerized farm accounting system provides. The tax report gives an early indication of the likely income tax position. At this date some management decisions can be made accordingly.

Lex Rutherford of the Livestock Branch says that the basic principle of the new Beef Grading System is to more precisely describe carcasses regarding quality and composition factors. This will allow the pricing system to more accurately react to consumption-market demand. At present A4 carcasses are selling at

four cents below A1. Those who have ordinarily produced and topped the market with the A4 type carcasses, are quite naturally upset by the new grading system. If however, demand for A4 type carcasses becomes stronger than for A1, we would expect a reversal. The new system simply says that A1 has less fat than A 4.
