On The Farm Front

CAYUGA - The Ontario R.O.P. Swine Committee reports five successful sales of Station Tested Boars. A total of 118 boars sold for an average of \$252. The highest price paid was \$645 for a Hampshire boar that indexed 155. Low indexing boars brought prices as low as \$65 and \$70. The next sale is to be held at the Waterloo Swine Test Station on Nov. 23.

Lower feed quality could occur this year because of the difficulty harvesting hay. Dairy-men can take this into account when calculating rations. A Feed analysis Service is available through the Ministry of Agriculture and Food, where required, at a charge of five dollars for each sample tested. County Extension Branch staff members would be prepared to discuss livestock rations with those who wish help.

Bruce Hearman, a Junior Farmer from Western Australia visited Haldimand County Nov. 10 to 17. During this interval Bruce stayed at the home of Rodney Fox, Cayuga. He reports that having is under way at the present time in Australia.

OPP Report

CAYUGA - During the past week, a total of 20 motor vehicle collisions were investigated resulting in injuries to five persons. The majority of these collisions occurred on Nov. 15 due to the first heavy snowfall. Driving too fast for road conditions and operating without snow tires were the major causes for most of the collisions.

Two break and enters were investigated as were eight charges laid under the Liquor Control Act. One youth was charged under the Fish and Game Act in Walpole Township with hunting ducks without a licence.

Interim Reports

All students at Hagersville Secondary School received their first report last week after two and a half months of studies. All work done has been evaluated, along with an assessment of each student's contribution to class. The reports are to be kept at home for future reference. Any parents with questions or comments are asked to call the school.

Promotion policy this school year is very similar to last year's. Work done every day is valued with an examination written in January. The work done from February until June will be weighed equally with the mark for the first half year.

A review of the local publication Dairy Dollars is under way. Haldimand Dairy-men have been asked to indicate whether or not they wish to continue receiving the publication. In addition their suggestions concerning Dairy Dollars have been requested. Other Haldimand dairy-men are invited to ask to be included on the mailing list.

The number of sheep breeders enrolling flocks on Sheep Performance Testing increased in 1972. Under this Ontario policy purebred and commercial sheep breeders are assisted in flock improvement with accurate productivity records of each ewe and with the rate of growth for each lamb. Enrollment should be made before the first of the new lamb crop is born with the Livestock Branch, Ontario Ministry of Agriculture and Food, Toronto.

R. W. Johnston, Soils Division, Ridgetown College of Agricultural Technology, says that a soil test is the best way to determine lime requirements. Many of the Haldimand soils need periodic correction of lime deficiency or acidity.
