vis; Rev. E. A. Ramratten of Wesley United Church, Jarvis; G. Arnold Creaser of Nanticoke United Church and Rev. Peter Brouwer of the Canadian Christian Reformed Church, Jarvis.

The first part of the service was the Preparation, including prayer for the new incumbent and the singing of the ancient Holy Ghost, our souls inspire."

Next the Bishop administered the oaths and declarations, the Rural Dean read the Bishop's licence and the Bishop delivered it to Mr. Perry with the words "Accept this charge, which is mine and thine, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." The induction was completed with the presentation of the Bible and Prayer Book to the Rector.

After Psalm 122 had been sung a procession led by crucifer David Fess moved to the font. The Bishop, his chaplain, the Archdeacon, Rural Dean and Rector were joined by the Churchwardens: Ralph Fess and Steve Payne of Jarvis and William Snowden and Jay Hedges of Nanticoke.

After a scripture passage read by the Archdeacon, the Bishop admonished the priest and the people on their duties in connection with Baptism, teaching the young, and setting them an example.

The procession then moved to the chancel steps where the pattern was repeated but dealing with preaching, marriage, visiting, burial and other pastoral duties.

At the altar he urged "Remember always to encourage God's family to gather around God's altar . . .", called on the congregation to be "The people of the resurrection, those who hold the world together."

The Induction took place in the midst of the congregation, and was conducted by Archdeacon Hill. The churchwardens handed Mr. Perry the keys of the churches. "In token that we acknowledge you as rector of this parish and pastor of its people." The Bishop added his blessing and the newly inducted Rector led the people in the Lord's Prayer.

Archdeacon Rigby, in his sermon, spoke of the parish as a family, preaching from the text "For this cause, I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord, Jesus Christ, of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named." He said that our family, and no less our parish, moulds our attitudes, style and quality of life.

"Your new Rector comes not to be head, but to occupy a unique place in the family of this parish" he said.

Family life, like every other facet of life is changing, but not necessarily for the worse. There is much more openness, more consultation and agreement rather than a "father - knows - best" authoritarianism. "Together, priest and people," said the Archdeacon, "you can be a living, growing community: the family of God in this place." The St. Paul's choir was directed by Rosemary Dell and Mrs. Helen Phibbs was organist.
