Jarvis firemen remained on the scene all of Monday night but the area was cordoned off from the public Tuesday night.

Wednesday morning workers began the task of trying to trace where the leak occurred. Each tank is being tested by pumping air into it and then a pressure gauge is placed on it to see if there is any air leaking out. Each gasoline line will also have to be tested.

A small tank has been placed on the service station lot and the gasoline that had drained into the sand is being pumped into it.

The Magic Mart store has been closed until further notice. County health officials will be testing foodstuffs in the store to determine if any contamination occurred from the gasoline fumes.
