ularly with the provincial governments, he said. And, the Council advises the Minister of Agriculture on all matters relating to the establishment and operation of agencies under the Act with a view to maintaining and promoting an efficient and competitive agriculture industry.

"As provided in the Act, eggs and poultry can be regulated and marketed by a national agency. Other products can be brought into a national plan at the request, but the National Farm Products Marketing Act has to be amended by Parliament if the producers wish to implement supply management or to impose production quotas."

Mr. Ferguson said he recognizes the need for quotas in the poultry industry due to the short reproduction cycle.

However, he would be reluctant to suggest quotas for other commodities because a national agency could coordinate and develop a drive for export markets. They could gear production to the specific grades and volumes needed to obtain long term contracts at prices that would ensure a profitable return to producers.

One of the prime objectives of these agencies will be to remove the cyclical peaks and valleys in relation to the prices... and to provide a stable farm income that will benefit consumer and producer alike," he added.

Mr. Ferguson also reported that The Canadian Egg Producers Council has worked for over a year to bring stability to the industry; public hearings have been held in Ottawa, Truro, Nova Scotia and Vancouver regarding a proposal for a National Turkey Plan and the Canadian Broiler Council is drafting a proposal

for a Canadian Broiler Agency.

Paul Babey, Chairman of the National Farm Products Marketing Council told the approximately 65 people at the dinner that there is a price associated with producers becoming involved in the marketing process. To start, it costs money. And so, it is important that producers accept the responsibility of providing the most able people to run the marketing, he said.

Producers must perform the roll of continual watchdog to see that the marketing board is fulfilling the objectives it is intended for. There is a role for everyone to fill, he said.
