## Nanticoke Environment Study Published

The Nanticoke Environmental Committee, composed of representatives from the Ministries of the Environment and Natural Resources, Ontario Hydro, The Steel Company of Canada Limited and Texaco Canada Ltd., has released the results of a four-year, \$333,000 study of the aquatic ecosystem of Long Point Bay in Lake Erie near Nanticoke.

The summary report is a baseline documentation of existing chemical, hydrological and biological conditions in the lake from 1967 to 1971, and it covers such fields as water chemistry, water movements and fisheries, which are considered necessary to assess the effects of the various discharges from the industries.

The various lake studies are continuing for the purpose of identifying any changes which may occur from 1972 to 1976 during the build-up of the industries in the Nanticoke district. Future plans include similar studies for several years after development in the area has been completed.

The committee was formed in 1968, a year after Ontario Hydro announced plans to construct a fossil-fired generating station on Lake Erie at Nanticoke, a region which supports active sports and commercial fisheries. At the time of its formation, the committee consisted of representatives from the Ministry of the Environment, the Ministry of Natural Resources and Ontario Hydro.

Later in 1968, Stelco joined the committee

when it announced plans for a development on the shoreline adjacent to the Ontario Hydro site. In early 1970, Texaco became a member as a result of its planned development in the area. When completed in 1977, the Nanticoke Generating Station will have a new output of 4,000 Megawatts at full capacity, making it the largest generating station of its kind in Canada. Stelco is now actively considering the location of a steel-making plant on its Nanticoke site and Texaco recently announced firm plans for building a refinery with a capacity of 95,000 barrels per day.
