A 22-year-old Jarvis youth was injured Friday night when he was involved in a two-car collision on Highway 3, just east of Simcoe. Carl Higgins was reported in fair condition Monday at Norfolk General Hospital with a broken wrist and possible internal injuries.

Maralee Osborne, 27, of Gibson Drive, Simcoe, driver of the other car, was treated for minor injuries. Daniel Findlay, 29, of R. R. 3, Simcoe, a passenger in the Osborne car, was also reported in fair condition at Norfolk General Hospital on Monday.

Damage was estimated at \$5,500.

Wheat At \$4 A Bushel

The Ontario Wheat Producers' Marketing Board has made the first sale of 1973 crop winter wheat for export at the highest price ever received since the board began operations in 1958.

Mr. K. A. Standing, secretary-manager of the marketing board said slightly more than 370,000 bushels were sold at a price over \$4.00 per bushel basis Montreal.

The sale was made to a traditional customer for immediate shipment according to the board official.

Mr. Standing also advised that the marketing board has taken possession of a volume in excess of five million bushels of the 1973 crop to date under the new agency marketing system. He said the board has moved about two million bushels into export position and the balance is moving into domestic positions.
