at that time your Department was concerned and possibly Dufferin Materials Ltd. would be asked to remove the fill if the material was found to be of an undesirable A follow up letter to let me know what action would be taken, with the

result of the soil test, and an assurance that contamination of fill would not be allowed. To my knowledge such a letter has not been received at this office. The complaints now state the fill being of a very light nature is


