TOWNSHIP OF RAINHAM NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

WHEREAS Karl E. Weselan, Consulting Engineer, on behalf of The Salvation Army has submitted to the Ontario Ministry of the Environment, plans for the establishing of lagoon and spray irrigation facilities in the Township of Rainham, to serve the Salvation Army Camp Selkirk, and has applied to the said Ministry for approval of such works in accordance with Section 42 of The Ontario Water Resources Act;

AND WHEREAS it appears from an examination of the said plans that the proposed sewage works will be located in the vicinity of the southeast quarter of Lot 3, Concession 1, in the Township of Rainham;

NOW THEREFORE this is to give notice that the Environmental Hearing Board of the said Ministry shall before giving its approval under said Section 42 on the 20th day of February, 1973, at 11:00 o'clock EST in the morning at the Rainham Community Centre, Fisherville, Ontario, hold a public hearing pursuant to Section 44 (1) of the said Act.

Query Quarry Dumping

Walpole Township Council is investigating dumping by Dufferin Materials and Construction Ltd. of materials into Hagersville area quarries.

At last Friday's meeting, clerk Dave Wilson read a letter for council which has been sent to Ontario Water Resources. It reads as follows:

The Township is still receiving complaints in regards to fill regulations on one quarry site. Some time ago, I contacted your Department on the phone in regards to the dumping of continuous light dust fill into a watered quarry hole on the south side of Mud Street, County Road No. 4. I was assured this trucking of fill would immediately stop as it could be a source of contamination to the under table water source thus extending trouble to the surrounding farmers who have suffered considerably in the past. In fact, it was stated on the phone, samples had been taken of this fill material and at that time your Department was concerned and possibly Dufferin Materials Ltd. would be asked to remove the fill if the material was found to be of an undesirable nature.

A follow up letter to let me know what action would be taken, with the result of the soil test, and an assurance that contamination of fill would not be allowed. To my knowledge such a letter has not been received at this office. The complaints now state the fill being of a very light nature is being dumped in the Quarry Hole, north of the County Road No. 4 and on occasion is a hazard to driving requiring car lights to be switched on for safe driving.

May I have a report on this matter to present to our Council at their next meeting.
