Mr. Hare also cautioned council to make sure the people of the area do not get "the worst of industry and not the best." "People are going to suffer and roads are going to be plugged. . . . We should make every effort to try and give these people the same effort and perhaps some more to make up for noise and smell."

Reeve Gordon Miller told the councillors he will not be casting a deciding vote in '73. "If there is a tie vote, it is a decision lost. I won't cast a deciding vote. It must be unanimous," he said.
