Number Of Mono Cases Is Not Abnormal

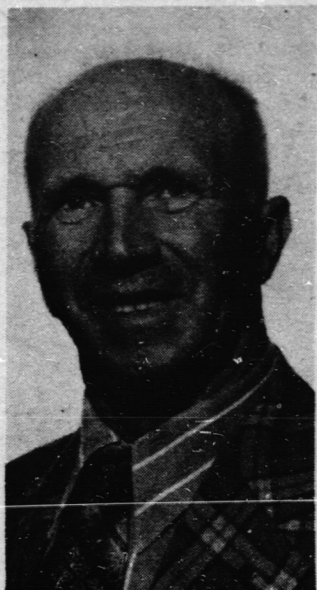
The "kissing" dis-
ease is not reaching
epidemic proportions in
the West Haldimand
area.
Rumor hinted that
mononucleosis cases
were setting a new
record for this winter.
However, the Marshall
Clinic has only dealt
with one or two cases,
Dr. P. A. Loveless
has not had too many
cases and Dr. W. C.
Powell's office reports
that there has been a
great number of mono
cases - but not an
abnormal amount. It's

the flu that is causing
trouble.
According to Dr. H. H.
Washburn, Director of
the Haldimand-Norfolk
Health Unit, Simcoe,
mononucleosis is a
disease of young people
between the ages 16-20
and is caused by an
unidentified virus.
The disease origi-
nates in the nose and
throat (it is often con-
fused with other nose
and throat diseases)
and travels fast with the
aid of a cough. It more
often affects young
people, he said, "be-

cause they spend more
time kissing."
It is an illness of
short duration which
normally lasts one or
two weeks. A sore
throat, fever, general
weakness, swelling of
the glands and some-
times a rash are
common symptoms of
mono. "It gets better
by itself and antibiotics
don't work on it...
They might even be
harmful," Dr. Wash-
burn said.
The reason it is called
mono, he added, is be-

cause it causes an
increase of monocytes
(one variety of cells)
in the blood.
(The Fisherville
Medical Clinic and Dr.
A. Lyons declined
comment).
