## S.W.E.E.P. Begins Project

Project S.W.E.E.P. 1973 will again work in conjunction with the Long Point Region Conservation Authority to provide the manpower required during the busy summer season. S.W.E.E.P. '73 has two major components: technical and labour.  
The ambitious technical program is designed to allow the authority to participate in programs promoting wise conservation practices. Four areas are under study: education, forestry, drainage and history.  
A comprehensive inventory of outdoor educational facilities within the Long Point Region Conservation Authority properties will be compiled. This inventory may be used by schools, or interested, mature study groups within the Long Point Watershed.  
Two forestry students have been hired to conduct an inventory of suitable areas for reforestation. The students will be visiting landowners in the Watershed who have small tracts of marginal land which would benefit from reforestation.  
In an effort to improve stability, effectiveness, and aesthetics of municipal drains, two students will be taking a complete inventory of the municipal drains within the Watershed.  
In conjunction with this inventory a series of test plots using different crop mixture, will be planted in early June. Historical research of the Backus Agricultural museum articles and ancillary incorporates a public interpretation program giving a life-like dimension to this rapidly expanding Canadiana collection.  
Residents of Hamilton, the Niagara Peninsula, all of southwestern Ontario, including the counties of Halton, Peel, Dufferin and Grey are invited to take part in this Juried exhibition.
