O.P.P. Report

During the evening of June 6-7, 1973, the South Walpole Elementary School, located on the Sandusky Road, Walpole Township, south of Highway No. 3 was entered. Once inside vandals set fires in the gymnasium and principal's office and broke numerous windows and various equipment causing extensive damage to the school. Nothing was stolen. This occurrence is presently being investigated by Prov. Const. J. C. Hanes, Cayuga Detachment. Any person having information concerning this please contact Cayuga O.P.P. at 772-3322.

Prov. Const. P. E. Segui, Cayuga Detachment, is investigating the theft of a 12 foot aluminum Feathercraft boat, blue over aluminum, taken during the evening of June 2, 1973 from a cottage owned by Frank Benson, located on Farr Road, Sherbrooke Township. There is a possibility that it may have been taken by joy riders and abandoned somewhere along the lake shore.

During this period there were ten various criminal code offences investigated by officers of this detachment including one charge of assaulting a police officer, laid against a London, Ontario youth. On Wednesday, June 6, 1973, Prov. Const. J. Termorshuizen, recovered a 1967 Lotus, stolen from a Hamilton car dealership, on the 2nd Concession, Seneca Township, completely burnt.

Officers of this detachment investigated fourteen motor vehicle collisions resulting in injuries to ten people. As a result of further investigation in regards to a serious collision on No. 6 Highway, north of Hagersville, on June 3, 1973, seven persons have been charged in contravention of the Liquor Control Act. During this period there were also thirteen investigations concerning contravention of the Liquor Control Act, resulting in charges being laid.
