Review Parking Proposal

The WH Record, Thursday, March 29, 1973 - 5

The sixth month wait for a draft proposal of Hagersville's new parking bylaw ended Monday night.

Council reviewed and made some changes to the proposal which will replace all previous parking bylaws for the village. And they gave it a first and second

reading. The bylaw will be sent to the Department of Transport for approval and then returned to council for a third and final reading. During the past month, there has been considerable contro-

very in the village over the enforcing of one section of the present bylaw which prohibits parking "on any roadway for an unreasonable time, having regard for the traffic requirements of such roadway and in no case for a longer period than three hours between 12 o'clock midnight and 7 o'clock a.m."

The new draft proposal prohibits parking for any "unreasonable" length of time and at any place that will interfere with snow removal or clearing. A time limit was not set.

Reeve John Kincaid said the "unreasonable" length of time should be left to the discretion of the local police. He pointed out that people do have flat tires or car trouble and

should not be bound by a specific time limit. Police Chief Warren Burger agreed there should not be a three hour limit. He said he was in favour of people parking on residential streets providing they don't obstruct fire trucks, snow clearing and don't leave a piece of junk on the street.

If a person has three cars, he can make extra

Brock was the only member who opposed this change in the bylaw.

He questioned the definition of "unreasonable length of time" and noted that people managed to stay off the streets when the present bylaw was being enforced.

Federation Facts

Too often the unfounded passer-by has seen poultry reared in cages or cattle tied in stalls and started an emotional public rejection of the farmer and his produce. This not only hurts that farmer, but all farmers.

The Ontario Federation of Agriculture asks the Ontario government to work with us to draft a Code of Practice for intensive livestock and poultry farming. The code must set out guidelines for sanitation, health, housing and comfort of stock. Regulations must be enforced by the Ministry of Agriculture and Food. A code of minimum standards will not only protect the good farmer, but also be the conscience of society, by setting standards that all farmers must maintain.

The above was one of the many items incorporated in the brief O.F.A. presented to the Ontario cabinet in January. O.F.A. had this to say about the Animal Medicines Act:

Delegates at our annual meeting in November insisted that veterinary drugs and supplies must be available to farmers through conventional outlets.

We are convinced that farmers will suffer both through inconvenience and through increased drug costs, if veterinary supplies are available only through veterinarians and pharmacists.
