On The Farm Front

The price of soybeans and soybean oil meal during the past few months has created some interest in the futures market. The assumption is that knowledge about futures trading in crops like soybeans and the feed grains might have provided protection against large price changes. It would appear that any farmer who fed, bought or sold 15 tons of grain, soybeans or soybean oil meal during the past winter could have benefited financially with information about the futures market. Plans are now under way to present a three day program on futures marketing, how it works and how farmers can use it. The course will be presented early enough that it can be used for the 1973 crop year. Announcement of dates and other details will be made soon.
