V.G. Margaret Payne had been kept very busy during the summer with gifts and remembrances to our members. Many thank-you and appreciation cards were received from various members.

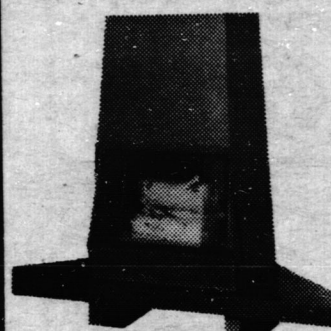
Notice of the installation dates in the district was received. Our installation is October 23rd.
