H-N Regional Council Friday, December 6 at 4 p.m. in an open session in Cayuga.

- Despite fear expressed by some councillors that the region is empire building, H-N authorized the Director of Engineering to advertise for employees for the Regional Water and Sewer Department.

The Regional Treasurer will use the Simcoe Public Utilities computer to process regional payrolls at a cost of 35 cents per cheque for salaried employees and 40 cents per cheque for Engineering hourly rated labor employees, plus an additional \$200 for a disc.

The Region is petitioning the Ministry of Natural Resources to implement legislation to control the destruction of trees on properties acquired before sub-divider agreements are presented.

An application for an Ontario Home Renewal Grant under The Housing Development Act will be made to the Ministry of Housing.

Administrator Dan Ciona said the region can receive a maximum \$251,703 for the improvement of homes. Simcoe, Dunnville and Nanticoke have expressed an interest in it.

Councillor John Roxburgh explained many senior citizens in the city have inquired about the home renewal grant for the repair of roofs on their houses.

Provincial Treasurer John White will meet with

agreed if the ministry can't get the highway in with the utilities, then the area can have two corridors. It will still be better than seven or eight, he said.

Otto Maier of the ministry told the audience the tentative routes require a maximum of 500 feet from Caledonia to Nanticoke and 300 feet from Caledonia to Hamilton. The entire length of the study area is 30 miles.

A man in the crowd later told the ministry officials he understood 900 feet was the desirable width.

Mr. Maier explained the 500 ft. figure was for the corridor to accommodate the road and utilities. If, however, it was to go along the hydro line, they would like to see an additional 400 foot green space, he said.

The five alternatives have been tagged the Highway 56 route, the East route, the Central route and the West route. (See map).

The ministry has defined major constraints and controls as the Niagara Escarpment Planning Area, Saltfleet Community Development Area, Mount Hope

Airport, Binbrook Conservation Area, Grand River Crossing, Six Nations and New Credit Reserves and various communities along Highway 6 (Caledonia, Hagersville and Jarvis).

Mr. Radbone said the group is now studying agricultural use, identifying buildings of historical and archaeological value, contacting the school board on bus routes and learning about localized climate (eg. snow drifting and fog areas).

Mr. Maier said the High 56 route is not a good choice for the utilities.

Three of the proposed routes, Central, CNR and East, assume Hamilton will build Red Hill Creek and mountain freeway.

A woman in the audience pointed out the only alternative left is the west route.

Admitting there is limited mountain access and great resistance to a new escarpment cut, Mr. Radbone pointed out there could be two corridors.

The Central Route runs parallel to the present Hwy. 6 and 3/4 miles east of it. Skirting Caledonia, it comes close to No. 6, joins


