## Museumobile To Visit

(continued from page 1) thick covered the land, hairy mastodons foraged for food along the fringes. Their skeletons, including tusks and teeth are found in Ontario. Fossil remains of sapelin, the fish that are a delicacy today in the Maritimes and Newfoundland indicate that the same fish swam up to Ottawa 12,000 years ago along the arm of the sea that is now the St. Lawrence River.

The final section represents the invertebrate fossils of the future. The tropical coral reef on display is the food and shelter for a great variety of animals and is typical of what would have been found in southern Ontario while it was under the sea. All of the invertebrates in this display, with the exception of sponges and gorgonian corals, commonly leave their skeletons as evidence of their existence.

The museumobile "Fossils of Southern Ontario" is designed to create a better understanding of the history of Ontario and the vital role fossils play in the recording of past events. Marine fossils, for example, indicate the province had been under water for millions of years.

The idea of the museumobile is part of the Royal Ontario Museum's department of education to send portable exhibits to communities throughout the province. They are designed for people of all ages, from the young to the old.
