nine in number from the originally planned six and offered a structure prepared by himself, Mrs. Smale and Mr. Whitehead - all of Simcoe. Except for two name changes, it was accepted by the council.

Town of Haldimand councillor Lyle Furry suggested a nine man committee would be too large and cumbersome. However, Mr. Judd argued a nine man committee would have each councillor serving on two committees which would create a better liaison within the council for the first year.

"I don't believe in big committees but we have a big area to cover," he said. "I think we have to respect all the interests of all the municipalities represented."

Councillor Lorna Miller supported the motion, pointing out that the system can be reviewed and revised at the end of the year. Nanticoke councillor Gordon Miller spoke against the increased numbers, pointing out that now "each committee is controlled by Norfolk County..."

Graeme Hedley, secretary - manager of the Ontario Beef Improvement Association, explained the present check - offs of 15 cents and 5 cents a head will be kept as long as farmers want it and the association can function with this amount of money.

Dr. Bill Clarke of the Fisherville Animal Clinic gave a detailed talk on internal and external parasites found in cattle.

He explained that until recently, little attention was paid to parasites in cattle. Now, however, whenever a group of cattle are not doing well, they are checked for parasites. If this is the problem, two wormings at three week intervals will show a remarkable improvement in growth and feeding, he said.

Some preventative measures, Dr. Clarke suggested were rotation of pasture, ploughing down a field and feeding cattle in a manger.

The eggs and larvae of parasites will die if pasture fields are rotated, leaving no animals to feed on or they are ploughed under.

If cattle eat out of a manger, rather than off the floor, there is also less chance of picking up a parasite, particularly if there is already a problem in the barn.
