Tom Huckwith of Cayuga is the newly-elected president of the Haldimand Division of the Ontario Secondary School Federation (OSSF), District Six. At an annual meeting held in Cayuga a week ago Tuesday, Mr. Huckwith defeated Dunnville candidate Foster Stark.

Paul Fisher of Hagersville Secondary School, Peter Hill of Caledonia High School and Mr. Stark were

installed as vice-presidents.

Other members of the executive are Secretary - Treasurer - John Cecchini of H.S.S., Communications Officer - Bill McKinnie of H.S.S., Epic Officer - Frank Schlichtherle and Principals' Representative - Bill Dowdell.

Mr. Huckwith takes the chair from Dave Aylsworth of H.S.S., 1973-74 president.

In his candidacy speech, Mr. Huckwith

said he was opposed to the issue of secrecy in negotiations; he would like to see a settlement with working conditions, saying the teachers are three years behind in non - salary items; and he would see whether it is advisable for Haldimand to remain in District Six.

The ninety teachers in attendance also paid tribute to retiring teachers John VanLoon, Joe St. Amand and Hubert H. Brown.

Mr. M. Mounk made presentations to them.
