On The Farm Front

It is our understanding from newspaper reports that the area councils and Haldimand-Norfolk Regional Council has processed by-laws under the Tile Drainage Act. This continues to permit farmers to borrow up to 75 percent of the cost of tile drainage work. Interest on these loans is at 4 percent. Payments are made over a ten year interval. Applications would be made before commencing the drainage work at the local municipal clerk's office.

According to Karl Bereza we can expect damage from the alfalfa weevil to reach economic level by June 8. Rapid weevil development is expected with warm weather. In Karl's words "Watch for a hot spell and larval explosion".

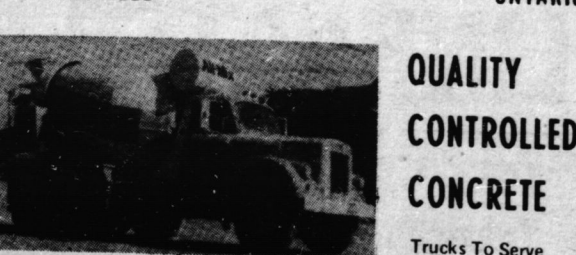
