Connestoga College
students, a trail was
roughed in the woods.
And, three students have
applied for an Opportu-
nities for Youth grant,
with the intention of
completing an inter-
pretative hiking trail for
everyone's use this
summer. They will also
write a history of
Taquanyah.

A Grand Opening
of the new resource
building there will be
held sometime in May.
At present, the public
isn't using Taquanyah
a great deal. But,
students, such as
Jarvis' group are
making up for it.

Hoops were used for
insect studies, concen-
trating mainly on galls,
a form found in plants
caused by wasp -
like flies by injecting a
fluid which irritates the
stems of plants.

The 340 acres of
marsh, woodlot and
bush - is open to the
public year round and
utilized by approximat-
ely 3,000 students for
practical study. Mr.
Seibert said the Hald-

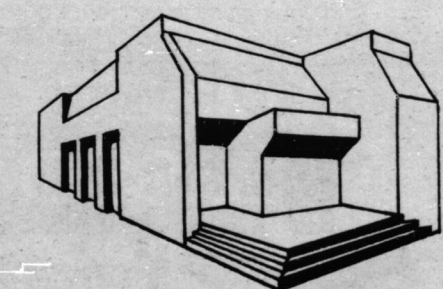
