

Mr. Ken Bartlett has been awarded a contract for garbage collection for the former Village of Jarvis. This contract is for the collection of household garbage only. City of Nanticoke Public Works Department employees will no longer be used for the collection of household garbage. City employees will, however, continue to collect commercial garbage and refuse until such time as a new By-law is passed to exclude commercial pick-up of any kind. Businesses so affected by this By-law will be notified when pick-up is discontinued. GARBAGE WILL, AS IN THE PAST BE PICKED UP

Collection will be carried out within the built-up area of the former Village. The limits extend to the points marked by the blue and white "Jarvis" signs located on Highways 3 Garbage should be placed at the side of the road prior to

ON THURSDAYS.

7 a.m. in the morning on the day of collection or after 7 p.m. the evening prior to collection Household garbage and refuse is defined as waste and refuse from the household preparation of food including glass and metal conainers, paper and plastic food containers, and wrappings, discarded newspapers, metal and plastic containers, wearing apparel, household linen, packaging from household items other than food and waste, excluding large appliance packaging, generated by the

normal operation of a household. Garbage shall be set out in containers or plastic bags, securely bound.

The weight of said containers, bags or otherwise shall not exceed forty (40) pounds Residents should place garbage in front of their residences adjacent to the travelled portion of the road. THIS SERVICE COMMENCES NOVEMBER 21ST,
