## H-N Wants Talk With White

(continued from page 1)  
Corporation which will plan and develop the Town within the guidelines of the Regional Official Plan and Regional Planning responsibility.

This is the kind of authority that the Regional Municipality of Durham is requesting. The time periods and red tape is significantly less than that of the Planning and Development Act.

Because of the growing pains the H-N Planning Department is going through now and the need to move in the housing direction, Mr. McCombs also rejected this alternative.

(3) A Subsidiary Corporation which themselves will be totally responsible for planning and developing the new Town with only the following regional relationship:

(a) The Subsidiary Corporation will be composed of approximately 12 members, three of whom will be Regional Councillors, one will be a City of Nanticoke

Councillor and two will be local citizens.

(b) The remaining six members will have the following background: one chairman, one development expert, one financial expert, one legal planning expert, one from the Housing Ministry.

Besides the Council representation on the Board of Directors of the Subsidiary Land Corporation, a further relationship with the Regional Planning Committee as an Advisory body to the Subsidiary Land Corporation.

Both Mr. McCombs and Regional Administrator Dan Ciona supported this suggestion.

"My main objective is to move housing starts in this area and have plenty of Regional Government input on this", Mr. McCombs said.

"I feel we will have this type of input without straining our planning department at this time."

(4) He described the fourth alternative as a movement away from the

Commission, Mr. Huget said both the lowest bidders for the project confirmed that the same building on a normal level site would cost \$72,000 and they were prepared to hold their price firm for 30 days for such an exchange.
