FARM FRONT

Among those things competing for Haldimand farmers' attention this week will be the International Plowing Match at Georgetown and Caledonia Fair. Plowing Match dates are September 24 to 28 and Caledonia Fair dates are September 26 to 29 inclusive. Both events will merit that attention.

Acres of crops grown in Haldimand and surrounding area have changed considerably over a five year period. The acreage of oats grown has reduced dramatically while the amount of barley and mixed grain has almost doubled. Grain and silage corn acreage is much larger. Acres in hay production are about the same in Haldimand but in surrounding areas are reduced substantially.

One part of the information that causes some concern is the acreage of hay per cattle head. For some reason there are 2.2 acres per head in Haldimand compared with 1.9 acres in Niagara and 1.2 acres in Wentworth. Brant and Norfolk have less than one acre of hay per head. Considering today's prices this difference may warrant investigation.

Crop Insurance coverage has been made available for fall seeded forage crops. These direct-seeded plantings

would be insured against establishment failure and other hazards including winterkill. Cost is 50 cents per acre.

Ralph Macartney, beef specialist, reminds that beef producers with the most profitable farms use superior gaining bulls and cull poor - producing cows. The Ontario Ministry of Agriculture and Food has a Beef Bull Testing and Herd Evaluation Program to help identify the best bulls and cows.

Continuing higher prices and shortages of fertilizer make soil testing even more important. A soil test will indicate the fertilizer application that will give the best results at least cost. Soil samples for next year's crop can be taken anytime now through until the ground is frozen. Soil boxes are available from the local agriculture office. No charge is made for the service.
