## Swine program expands

The Ontario Swine Performance Testing Program under the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture and Food is being expanded to include commercial herds. When the program was initiated in 1967 only purebred breeders were eligible to participate. In making the announcement, the Honourable William A. Stewart, Minister of Agriculture and Food said: "The expanded program will provide Ontario commercial hog producers with the necessary accurate performance information to make the selection of superior animals."

Gilts in herds enrolled in the program will be weighed and ultrasonically backfat probed on the farm free of charge by technicians of the Ministry of Agriculture and Food.

Performance information provided will include backfat thickness and age adjusted to 200 pounds. Commercial producers will be in a position to make marked improvements in the carcass index and

improving the quality of hogs by selecting replacement gilts on the basis of test results and by using superior performance tested boars.

Herd owners making use of the expanded program will be required to provide an accurate scale, identify gilts individually before weaning, and record their birth dates as well as the identification of both sire and dam.

"This expanded Swine Testing Program is another step towards further

improving the quality of Ontario hogs which presently enjoy a growing international reputation," Mr. Stewart concluded.

Farmers interested in having gilts weighed and probed under the Swine Performance Testing Program should write for further details to the Livestock Branch, Ontario Ministry of Agriculture and Food, Parliament Buildings, Toronto, M7A 1A5 or contact their local agricultural representative's office.

High winds and drifting snow brought most activities in the Nanticoke area to a standstill on Thursday.

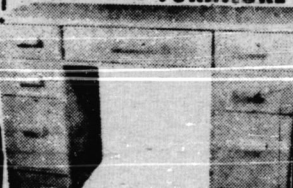
