Councillor Keith Shay, who questioned McKeough about room on the Townsend site for the administration offices, said, "In January of this year, we passed a resolution that we should consolidate our administration in the Jarvis area. It is time we got everyting all under one roof. Jarvis is the central point of the region, and as such is the obvious place for the administration centre."

Mr. McKeough replied, "It would be better to wait. The proof of the pudding is that we now have two very beautiful buildings that are in the wrong place. Lets not do it again."
