## Belt-up and live

Canadians from coast to coast will soon be the target of a special effort by Health and Welfare Canada to encourage the use of seat belts.

The federal government's health department has issued a special pamphlet entitled "Belt-up!" which will be mailed to every household in the country. The objective is to make the public aware of the importance of wearing seat belts.

Every year more than 6,000 persons die on Canadian highways - in 1973, more than 220,000 Canadians were injured - yet, according to statistics, only about 15 percent of the population uses seat belts.

It is estimated, the health department says, that automobile accident deaths alone could be reduced by as much as 40 percent if all occupants chose to wear the available seat belts.

## Sculpture new part of Friendship Weekend

A large new sculpture taking shape on the lawn outside the Lynnwood Arts Centre will highlight the upcoming Simcoe Friendship Festival, July 31 to August 4. Under the "Artists with their Work" program of the Art Gallery of Ontario Extension Services, Ron Baird will create a new work designed especially for the Festival. The large, welded kinetic sculpture will remain in Simcoe permanently. Visitors are welcome to talk with Mr. Baird as he

assembles the 8 by 8-foot piece, and in addition to observing the work in progress, they may examine four other completed sculptures of Baird's which will be on display until September 2. Through Outreach Ontario, a crew from the Ontario Educational Communications Authority will film Baird at work on the new sculpture. The resulting half-hour film on "Artists with their Work" will be screened this fall on Channel 19. Members of Club Laval will

be hosting the opening ceremonies between 6 and 6 p.m. on July 31. The public is welcome to sample traditional French Canadian food which will be served on the lawn, cafe-style, throughout the Festival.

Ron Baird was born in Toronto and graduated from the Ontario College of Art in

1964. He soon became resident sculptor at the school of architecture at the University of Toronto and was appointed to the executive of the Sculptors Society of Canada. Mr. Baird has a studio at Stouffville, and most recently participated in a group exhibition of regional artists at the Robert

McLaughlin Gallery in Oshawa.

The Art Gallery of Ontario has worked closely with Festival Ontario and the Simcoe Friendship Festival on the program. Festival Ontario is an activity of the

Ministry of Culture and Recreation and is designed to make provincial cultural resources more readily available to people throughout Ontario by offering them free to community festivals.


