NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL TO EXPROPRIATE LAND THE EXPROPRIATIONS ACT Chapter 154 - R.S.O., 1970

IN THE MATTER of an application by The Regional Municipality of Haldimand-Norfolk (expropriating authority) for approval to expropriate land being Part Lots 11 to 23 Inclusive Concession 1, Lots 7 and 12 to 23 Inclusive Concession 2, in the Geographic Township of Walpole in the City of Nanticoke and Lots 7 to 11 Inclusive Concessions 1 and 2 in the Geographic Township of Rainham in the Town of Haldimand in the Region of Haldimand-Norfolk for the purpose of widening Regional Road 3 (Rainham Road) NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that application has been made for approval to expropriate the land described as follows:

Road Widening to provide a 50 foot right-of-way as discussed at the site.

Any owner of lands in respect of which notice is given who desires an inquiry into whether the taking of such land is fair, sound and reasonably necessary in the achievement of the objectives of the expropriating authority shall so notify the approving authority in writing.

(a) in the case of a registered owner, served personally or by registered mail within thirty days after he is served by publication of the notice.

(b) in the case of an owner who is not a registered owner, within thirty days after the first publication of the notice.

1. The Expropriations Act, 1970 provides that: (a) where an inquiry is requested, it shall be conducted by an inquiry officer appointed by the Minister of Justice and Attorney General.

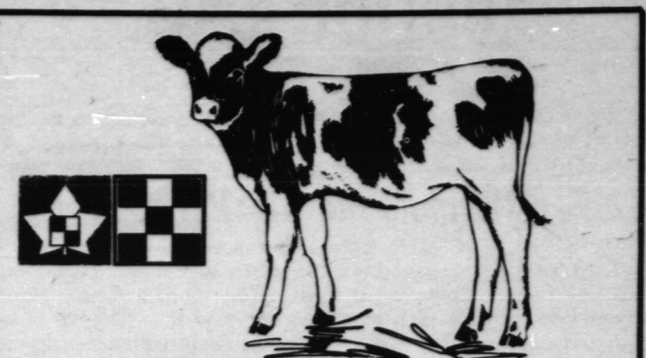
(b) the inquiry officer: (i) shall give every party to the inquiry an opportunity to present evidence and argument and to examine and cross-examine witnesses, either personally or by his counsel or agent, and may recommend to the approving authority that a party to the inquiry be paid a fixed amount for his costs of the inquiry not exceed \$200.00 and the approving authority may in its discretion order the expropriating authority to pay such costs forthwith.

2. "Owner" and "Registered Owner" are defined in the Act as follows: "Owner" includes a mortgagee, tenant, execution creditor, a person entitled to a limited estate or interest in land, a committee or the estate of a mentally incompetent person or of a person incapable of managing his affairs and a guardian, executor, administrator or trustee in whom land is vested.

"Registered Owner" means an owner of land whose interests in the land is defined and whose name is specified in an instrument in the proper registry, land titles or sheriff's office, and includes a person shown as a tenant of land on the last revised assessment roll.

3. The expropriating authority, each owner who notifies the approving authority that he desires a hearing in respect of the lands intended to be expropriated and any owner added as a party by the inquiry officer are parties to the inquiry.

Where this notice is published, the following shall appear in each publication: "This notice first published on the 28th day of May, 1975."

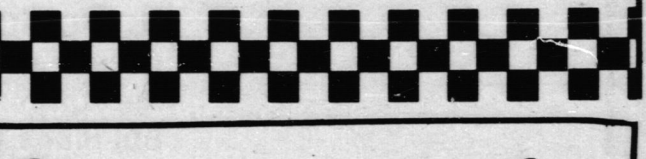

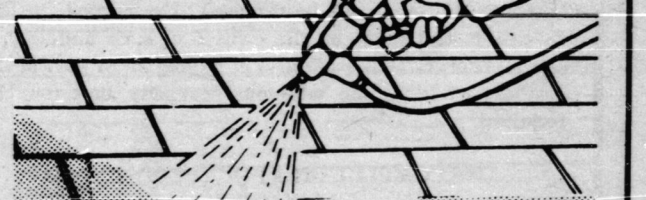
